
STEP 2: Use the login credentials included in the email to log into your account at <u>aurorauniversity.okta.com</u>.


**STEP 4:** You will then have access to your **Okta dashboard**; you will see limited information until you are ready to register for classes at AU.

Outlook, which is your **AU email**.




Zendesk is available if you need any technical assistance from our Information Technology Services department.




Students have 24/7 access to medical and mental telehealth services through TimelyCare.
