- Test taken prior to 9/1/15: Composite score of 22 AND a combined English/Writing score of 19

Math Exemptions for Education Majors: Candidates can proficiency out of MTH 1210 Math for Elementary Teachers I and/or MTH 1220 Math for Elementary Teachers II by scoring an ACT Math score of 26 on the math portion/subtest only; Candidates can proficiency out of MTH 1210 for Elementary Teachers I by scoring an ACT Math score of 23-25. This score must only be on the math portion/subtest

- <u>Tests taken on/after 3/5/2016</u>: Composite score of 1110 (Evidence-based Reading and Writing + Mathematics = 1110 or higher) and a minimum score of 26 on Writing and Language Test
- <u>Tests taken prior to 3/5/2016</u>: Composite score of 1030 (Critical Reading + Mathematics = 1030 or higher) and a minimum score of 450 on Writing

Math Exemptions for Education Majors: Candidates can proficiency out of MTH 1210 Math for Elementary Teachers I and/or MTH 1220 Math for Elementary Teachers II by scoring an SAT Math score of 590-600 on the math portion/subtest only
