What do Mexico and France have in common? More than you might think. In this course, you'll travel to France to explore the history, migration patterns, and cultural exchanges that support Mexican and French relations.

Through readings, discussions, and immersive experiences, you'll build your skills for identifying cross-cultural connections while visiting worldclass cities like Paris, Lyon, Barcelonnette, and either Marseille or Nice. Along the way, you'll pick up survival French for everyday travel situations and dive into topics related to French-Mexican relations vis-à-vis art. literature, food. and the movement of people across borders. You'll see migration and integration in a new light — understanding not just the connections between Mexico and France, but also how cultural exchange impacts communities worldwide.
