

## INTERNATIONAL APPLICANTS

### Statement of Financial Resources Information Sheet

In accordance with the U.S. Department of Immigration and Naturalization Service (INS) regulations, Aurora University requires that all international applicants show proof of sufficient funds to cover expenses for at least one full year of study. It is assumed that similar funding will be available for their entire course of study. In addition to meeting all academic requirements for admission to Aurora University, the international applicant must submit the following Financial Resource Statement before becoming eligible to receive the I-20 Visa Form. Since need-based financial aid is not available to international students requiring an I-20, it is important that adequate financial resources be demonstrated.

International applicants must meet the following requirements (*in addition to academic requirements*):

- Show proof of ability to cover expenses for at least one full year of study at Aurora University.
- Apply for full-time student status (required for I-20 Visa).
- Submit an official bank letter and sponsor letter (if necessary) with the Financial Resource Statement.

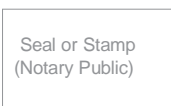
