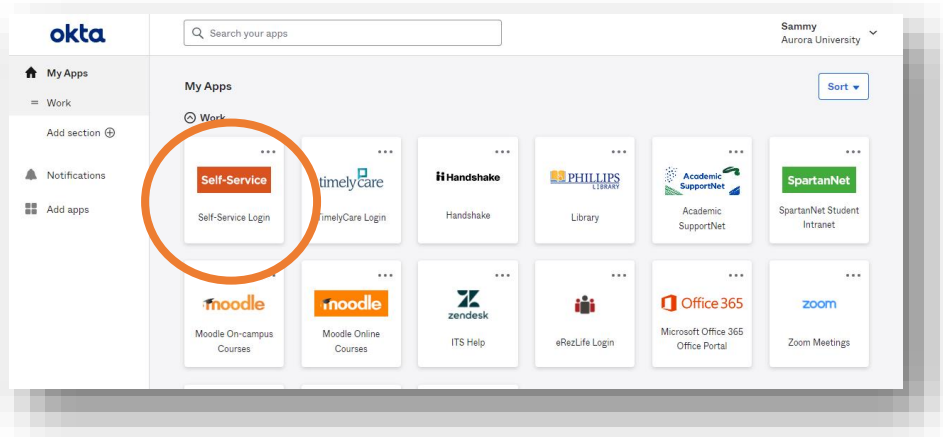
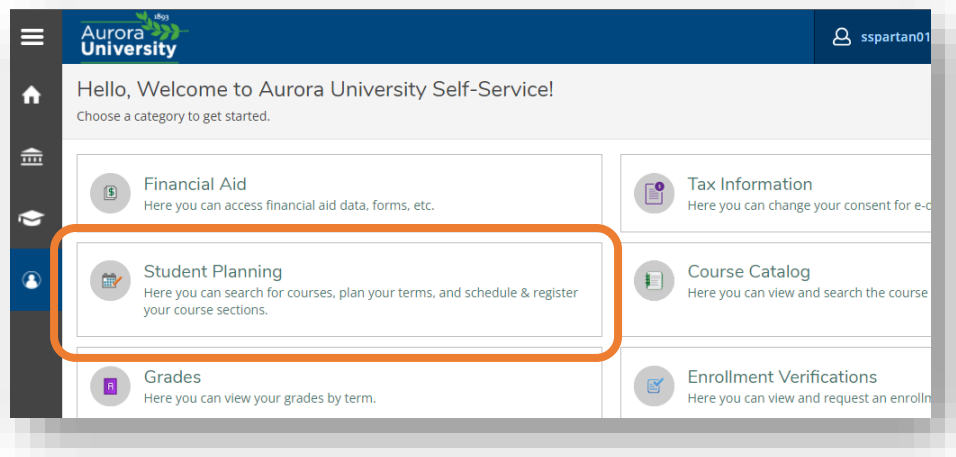


Viewing and Printing Your Schedule in Student Planning

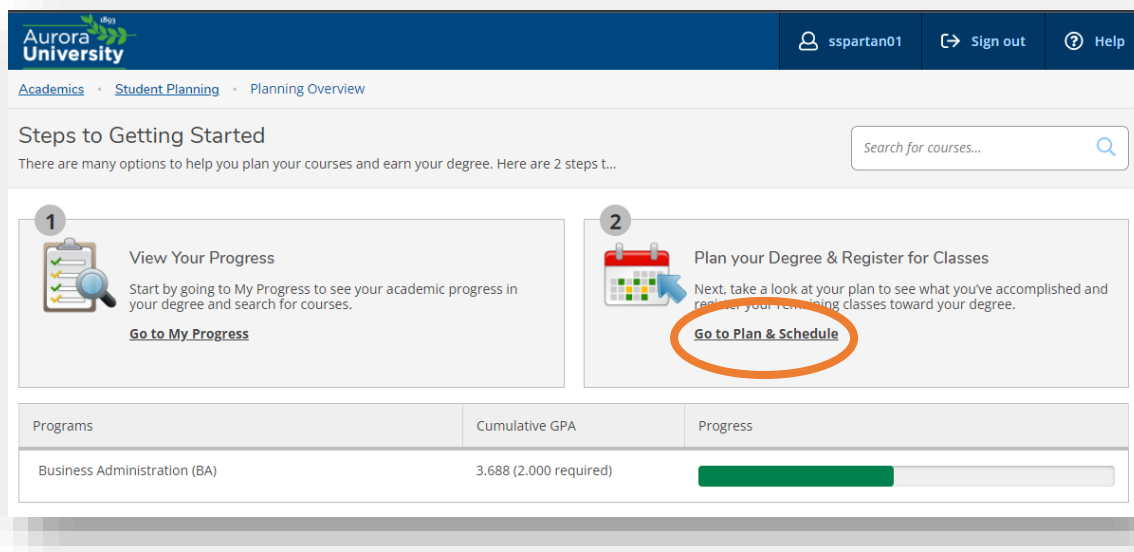
STEP 1: After logging into your **Okta dashboard** at aurorauniversity.okta.com, click on the **Self-Service** application.
