The National Science Foundation Robert Noyce Teacher Scholarship program is designed to help address the nationwide shortage of high-quality teachers in science, technology, engineering, and math, particularly among groups underrepresented in STEM fields.

The program, known as Noyce Scholars, is open to select **Biology**, **Chemistry**, and **Mathematics** majors entering their junior year at AU. **Noyce Scholars will receive an annual undergraduate scholarship of up to \$18,000 for the last two years of their secondary education program.**

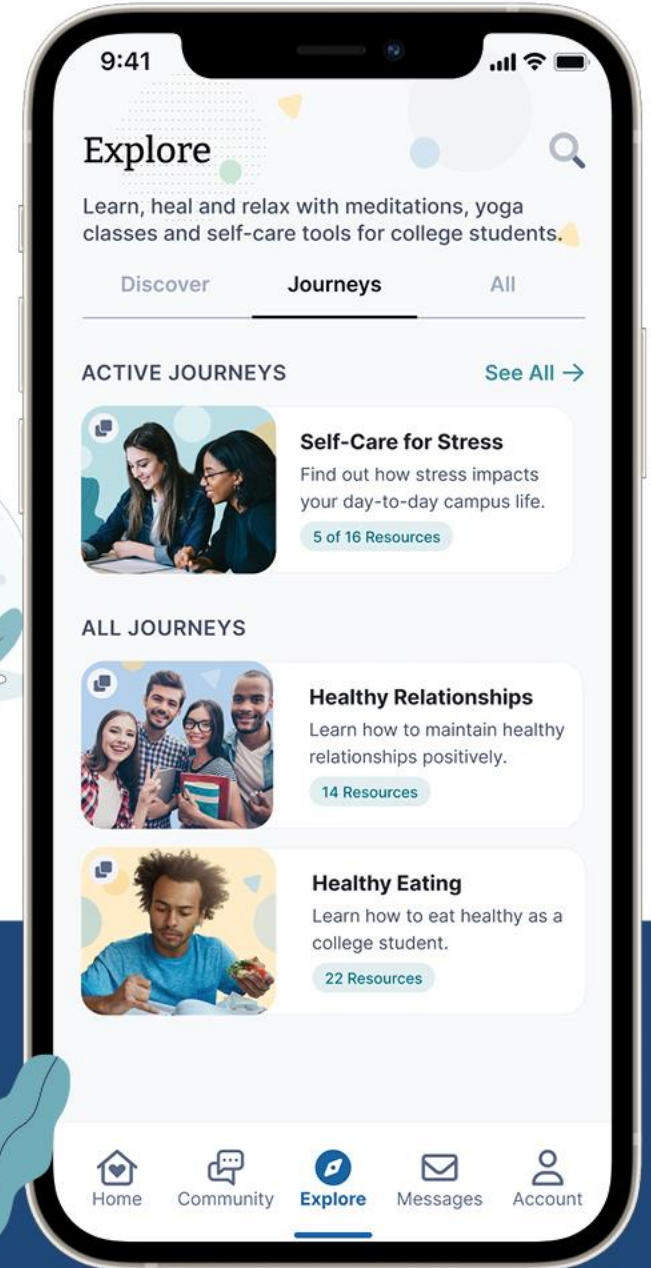
