

2022-23 Proof of Illinois Residency

Recipients of the IL MAP Grant must be residents of the State of Illinois. Before the IL MAP Grant can be applied, AU is required to verify IL residency for you (if independent) or your parent (if dependent).

DO NOT SUBMIT THIS DOCUMENTATION IF IT HAS NOT BEEN REQUESTED.

DEPENDENT STUDENTS

For a dependent student to be considered an Illinois resident, his/her parent from the 2022-23 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) must physically reside in Illinois and Illinois must be his/her true, fixed, and permanent home.

Preferred Documentation to Prove IL Residency:

- Copy of Valid Parent IL Driver's License
- Copy of Valid Parent IL State ID
- Signed and Dated Copy of Parent 2021 IL State Tax Return

INDEPENDENT STUDENTS

For an independent student to be considered an Illinois resident, he/she must have physically resided in Illinois for 12 continuous months immediately prior to the start of the 2022-23 academic year and Illinois must be his/her true, fixed, and permanent home.

Preferred Documentation to Prove IL Residency (prior to August 29, 2022):

- Copy of Valid IL Driver's License
- Copy of Valid IL State ID
- Signed and Dated Copy of Student 2021 IL State Tax Return

If you are unable to provide one of the preferred items, contact the Office of Financial Aid.
