FINANCIAL AID FOR GRADUATE STUDENTS STARTING **SUMMER 2026**

Step 1: Submit Summer Aid Application

Summer Aid Applications are available beginning in <u>February</u> (S1 at <u>aurora.edu/forms2025</u>).

Step 2: File/Update FAFSAs

The 25-26 FAFSA is used for the summer semester, whereas the 26-27 FAFSA is used for the upcoming Fall 2026 and Spring 2027 semesters. Log on to <u>fafsa.gov</u> to file.

You may file the 26-27 FAFSA beginning in October 2025.

If you have already filed the 25-26 FAFSA as an undergraduate student, update the questions listed below and submit the updated FAFSA on <u>April</u> 1, 2026.

Step 3: Complete Financial Aid Checklists

Review your Financial Aid Checklists on your <u>Self-Service</u> account for items marked as "Action Needed" and complete these steps. Make sure to complete requests for both summer and 26-27 aid.

Financial Aid Eligibility

- No grants available
- Annual Federal Direct Unsubsidized Loan Limit is \$20,500
 - o If you borrowed \$7,500 as an undergraduate student during the fall and spring semesters, you could have up to \$13,000 left for the following summer semester (\$20,500 \$7,500 = \$13,000) depending on your Cost of Attendance
- If additional aid is needed, inquire with the Office of Financial Aid for other options
