1. Aurora University overall GPA of 3.0 (must be here a semester before application to college can be completed)
2. Passing the Illinois Test for Academic Proficiency (TAP). You can be waived out of the TAP if you have taken the ACT plus Writing in the last 10 years **AND** received a composite score of 22 **AND** received a score of 6 on the Writing portion. You can also be waive out with the SAT with Essay in the last 10 years **AND** received a composite score of 1110 (Reading and Writing + Mathematics) **AND** a minimum score of 26 on the Writing and Language Test.

4. Finger printing in Kane County
5. Negative result on a TB test
