You can be waived out of the TAP if you have taken the ACT plus Writing in the last 10 years **AND** received a composite score of 22 **AND** received a score of 6 on the Writing portion. You can also be waived out with the SAT with Essay in the last 10 years **AND** received a composite score of 1110 (Reading and Writing + Mathematics) **AND** a minimum score of 26 on the Writing and Language Test.

5. Negative result on a TB test
